41st City Senior Men's Championship Tournament July 14-15, 2009 - Tuesday & Wednesday BING MALONEY GOLF COURSE

****This is a NCGA 150 Level Player Point Tournament****

On-line Registration: sacgolfcouncil.org for on-line registration – please note \$10 administrative charge for any withdrawal for on-line registration

- Eligibility:** Open to all male amateur golfers age 55 and older as of July 7th that are members of an organized golf club with an established USGA Index of 19.8 or less. Proof of age must be presented at the tournament registration table prior to teeing off.
- Entry Fees:** \$115 per player - Includes two (2) days green fees and awards—power cart not included. Deadline for entry is July 7 and no refunds after the July 7 deadline. Entry request for twosome together is acceptable. Request for a foursome is not allowed. Index is used only for placing players in comparable foursomes. There will be a \$25 service charge for returned checks.
- Format:** 36 holes of stroke play—18 holes each day. **Championship flight is played at scratch.** Championship flight contestants must have an index of 7.5 or less. **Handicap flights play at full handicap.** The field will be divided evenly subject to the number of entries received. Ties in the championship flight for champion is decided by an immediate sudden death playoff at medal play.
- Awards:** **In the championship flight the individual with the lowest 36-hole gross score will be declared the 2009 Sacramento City Sr. Men's Champion** and his name will be inscribed on the perpetual trophy. Ties in this flight are divided evenly by the sum of the combined places. **Handicap flight awards are based on net scores. Ties in this flight are broken based on the USGA recommended method, Rule 33-6, Decision of Ties.** Presentation of awards will take place immediately following the conclusion of the tournament. Winners are requested to be present for the awards.
- Rules:** Players will follow USGA Rules, except for Local Rules posted by the Tournament Committee prior to play. In the absence of a Rules Official, competitors shall use Rule 3-3 (Doubt as to Procedure, play a second ball) and refer any disputes to the Tournament Committee, whose decision shall be final. If any point in dispute is not covered by USGA or local rules, the decision shall be made in accordance with equity (Rule 1-4—Points Not Covered by Rules.) The use of cellular phones/pagers or any similar equipment on the golf course during competition is prohibited.
- Times:** Players must check in at least 30 minutes prior to their scheduled starting time. It is the player's responsibility to be on the first tee at their assigned tee time (Rule 6.3). Late competitors must be ready to play within five minutes of their assigned tee time under a penalty of two (2) strokes. Penalty for failure to comply is disqualification. Starting times will be posted on the SGC website www.sacgolfcouncil.org one week prior to the event, or you may call the golf shop at (916) 808-2283 or you may call Shirley Johnson, Tournament Director, at (916)455-0590. To reserve power carts call the golf shop.
