



# 13th Annual STATE FAIR JUNIOR CHAMPIONSHIP

Saturday, August 28, 2010

- Eligibility:** This tournament is open to all junior golfers under the age of 18 as of August 28, 2010
- Entry Fees:** \$55 per player-age 12-17; \$30 per player-age 11 and under. Fee includes: entry, green fees, lunch, tee prizes, and awards. **NO REFUNDS. ENTRIES POSTMARKED PRIOR TO JULY 1, 2010 WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.** This tournament fills quickly and entries should be submitted at the earliest acceptable date. Deadline for entry is 5:00PM August 15. Submission of an entry indicates wiliness on the part of the player to abide by the rules and decisions of the Tournament Committee. There will be a \$20 service fee on all returned checks.
- Format:** BOYS ages 14 to 17 will play 18 holes of medal play on the MATHER COURSE. The boys 12-13 and the girls 12 to 17 will play 18 holes of metal play on the Alister MacKenzie G.C. Boys and girls age 10-11 will play 9 holes with a shotgun start on the Arcade Creek golf Course. The 9 and under players will have tee times on the Arcade Creek Course. Ties for the boys and girls champion will be played off, as will the first place in each age group. All other ties will be broken in accordance to USGA Rule 33-6.
- Awards:** Boys and Girls Low Gross over the field will have their names placed on the perpetual trophies. Awards will be presented to the low gross scorers in each age group. Presentation of awards will take place following the conclusion of the tournament. **All winners are requested to be present to accept their awards.** Final results will be posted on the SGC website.
- Rules:** All play will follow United States Golf Association (USGA) Rules, except for Local Rules posted by the Tournament Committee prior to play. In the absence of a Rules Official, competitors shall refer any disputes to the Tournament Committee, whose decision shall be final. All players must abide by the JGANC rules. **CADDIES ARE NOT ALLOWED.** spectators must stay at least 25 yards away from players at all times AND **MUST STAY ON CART PATHS.** Players are not permitted to converse with parents or spectators during play. Misconduct will result in player disqualification. Players are responsible for returning their own attested and correct scorecard (rule 6-6b). Players are responsible for being on the tee when called, or an appropriate penalty will be assessed. The use of cellular phones, pagers, cameras or any similar equipment on the golf course during competition is prohibited.
- UNSPORTSMANLIKE CONDUCT – The use of abusive language, throwing of golf clubs, or other disruptive behavior will not be allowed – PENALTY: DISQUALIFICATION  
**Recommended dress code:** appropriate golf attire – shirts with sleeves, no tank tops – shorts should be hemmed just above the knee, or slacks – denim clothing is discouraged. Haggin Oaks and Mather are spikeless facilities. Metal, penetrating golf shoe spikes are prohibited.
- Starting Times/**
- Check in:** **Boys 14-17 must check in at Mather by 6:30AM for a 7AM shotgun start. Boys 12-13 and girls 12-17 and all 10-11 age players must check in by 7AM at Haggin Oaks for 7:30AM shotgun start. All players 9 and under must sign in at Haggin Oaks 30 minutes prior to their tee time. Tee times for age 9 and under will be posted at the golf shop, and also will be posted on the Council website at [www.sacgolfcouncil.org](http://www.sacgolfcouncil.org) one week prior to the day of play.**
