# 2010 44<sup>th</sup> Annual California State Fair Men's Net Championship Sept 4, 5, & 6 2010 Ancil Hoffman Golf Course

*Co-Sponsored by: County of Sacramento, Regional Parks*

**Registration:** Available at [www.sacgolfcouncil.org](http://www.sacgolfcouncil.org) - Online registration or mail entry form with fee.

**Entry Fee: \$150.00** - Entry fee includes all green fees for three days if cut is made, administrative costs and awards. Entry does not include golf cart. **Entries close on Wednesday August 25, 2010. No refunds after the closing date.** Those seeking refunds should contact Jim Fuoti at 916 798-1865 or [Fuoti@sbcglobal.net](mailto:Fuoti@sbcglobal.net). All cancellations approved will be charged a \$10.00 fee. Do not call the golf shop for refunds. A \$20.00 service charge on all returned checks will apply.

The field is limited to the first 144 players with an application and payment of fees received by the Committee. Submission of an entry form indicates willingness on the part of the player to abide by the rules and decisions of the Tournament Committee.

**Eligibility:** This tournament is open to amateur golfers, age 18 and older, who are members of an organized golf club with a current 2010 handicap between 5 and 20. Participants will be paired within their respective flights. In Accordance with USGA rule 33-1 and 10-3/E the SGC has the authority to adjust a handicap based on tournament scores. Entries that exceed the maximum 20 strokes, must agree to play at the 20 maximum handicap allowed.

**Format:** 54 holes of stroke play over three days based on the August 15, 2010, Handicap Index or August 1, 2010, if mid-month adjustment not available. The field will be divided into flights commensurate with total entries. The field will be reduced by approximately 50% after day two results are posted. Those making the 36-hole cut will play 18 holes on the final day.

**Ties:** All ties are broken according to the USGA Recommended Rule 33-6, matching scorecards. Exception: Ties for the low net score for the tournament will be broken by a sudden death play-off with appropriate handicaps to determine the California State Fair Net Champion.

**Awards:** The player with the total low net score will be declared the 2010 California State Fair Net Champion and his name will be inscribed on the perpetual trophy and awarded a gift certificate and personal Individual trophy. Other prizes will be awarded based on net scores in each flight. Presentation will take place directly following the completion of the tournament. All winners not present to accept their awards will receive them via mail. Payments will be made to approximately 35% of the field.

**Rules:** All play will follow United States Golf Association (USGA) Rules, Local Rules of the course, and other rules posted by the Tournament Committee prior to play. Tournament Committee decisions will be final. Decisions not covered by USGA or Local Rules, will be made in accordance with equity.

Players are responsible for returning their signed attested scorecards to the scoring table immediately following each round. Except for emergencies, the use of cell phones is prohibited during play.

**Carts:** Cost not included in the entry fee. AHGC cart policy: \$36.00 per cart. Cost can be shared by riders. Individuals will be charged for a full cart if unwilling to share. To reserve carts, contact the Golf Shop at (916) 482-3284.

**Check-in:** All rounds will start when scheduled. Contestants must check in at the tournament registration table at least 30 minutes prior to their starting time. Tee times will be posted at [www.sacgolfcouncil.org](http://www.sacgolfcouncil.org) and will be available at Ancil Hoffman GC at (916) 482-3284 one week prior to the tournament.
