**NOTICE** This is an NCGA Player 250 Point Tournament!

**Eligibility:** This tournament is played at scratch and open to all male amateur golfers age 55 and older with an Index Of 7.9 or less, for the full championship event. Proof of age must be presented prior to teeing off on the first day of the tournament. **Entry Fees:** \$165.00 per player; **this fee does include three (3) days green fees, range balls, and awards. (Power Cart Not Included).** **NEW EVENT: STATE FAIR SUPER SENIORS. THIS IS A NON NCGA PLAYER POINTS EVENT FOR AWARDS ONLY. PLAY FROM THE WHITE TEES. TWO ROUNDS FOR SENIORS 65 AND OLDER WITH AN INDEX OF 8.5 OR LESS PLAYED AT SCRATCH. 9/5 SAT & 9/6 SUN. ENTRY FEES: \$125.00 THIS FEE INCLUDES TWO (2) DAYS GREEN FEES, RANGE BALLS, AND AWARDS. CARTS NOT INCLUDED! Deadline for entry is August 29, 2010 FOR BOTH EVENTS. No refunds after this date.** Please contact **Tournament Director, Ken Smith** regarding cancellations at (916) 723-3809, **ALL CANCELLATIONS WILL INCUR A \$10.00 Fee;** do not call the golf shop. Field is limited to paid entries from the first 144 players. Submission of a signed or electronic entry indicates willingness on the part of the player to abide by the rules and decisions of the Tournament Committee. **There will be a \$25 service charge on all returned checks.**

**ELECTRONIC ENTRY AVAILABLE!** *You are now encouraged to make your entry through the Sacramento Golf Council web site [www.sacgolfcouncil.org](http://www.sacgolfcouncil.org). (BLUE GOLF) ONLY VISA & MASTERCARD credit cards are accepted. Direct entries by mail, checks only will be accepted.*

**SENIOR Format:** Play will be 54 holes of stroke play (18 holes each day) at scratch. Players who tie for the Championship will be asked to break the tie in a play-off **IF POSSIBLE.** Other ties will have awards based on the USGA recommended method [Rule 33-6]. **USGA APPROVED RANGE FINDERS ALLOWED!**

**SUPER SENIOR FORMAT:** PLAY WILL BE 36 HOLES OF SCRATCH STROKE PLAY, (18 HOLES PER DAY) TIES WILL BE DETERMINED BY COMPARISON OF SCORE CARDS

**Awards:** The player with the total low GROSS score for 54 holes will be declared the CALIFORNIA STATE FAIR SENIOR MEN'S CHAMPION. The winner's name will be inscribed on the perpetual trophy. Merchandise awards are redeemable in the golf shop to the high finishers. The amount and number of merchandise certificates will be determined by the size of the field. Presentation of awards will take place immediately following the conclusion of the tournament. All winners are requested to be present to accept their awards. **NCGA Player Points will be awarded to the top five (5) finishers who are NCGA members, by NCGA.**

**Rules:** All play will follow United States Golf Association (USGA) Rules, except for Local Rules posted by the Tournament Committee prior to play. **IN THE ABSENCE OF A RULES OFFICIAL, COMPETITORS SHALL USE RULE 3-3 (PLAY A SECOND BALL) AND REFER ANY DISPUTES TO THE TOURNAMENT COMMITTEE, WHOSE DECISION SHALL BE FINAL.** If any point in dispute is not covered by USGA or Local Rules, the decision shall be made in accordance with equity (Rule 1-4 Points Not Covered by Rules). Players are responsible for returning their own attested and correct scorecard at completion of play (Rule 6-6b). Players are responsible for being on the first tee at their assigned tee time, or an appropriate penalty (Rule 6-3 and 33-7) will be assessed. The use of cellular phones/pagers or any similar equipment on the golf course during competition is prohibited. **Dress code:** Appropriate golf attire— shirts with sleeves - no tank tops, short shorts, or jeans are allowed.

**Starting Times/Check-in:** *All rounds will start when scheduled. Contestants must check in at the tournament registration table at least 20 minutes prior to their starting time. Start times will be posted on the SGC website [www.sacgolfcouncil.org](http://www.sacgolfcouncil.org) and will be posted at Mather Golf Shop three days prior to the event and will also be available by calling Mather Golf Shop at (916) 364-4354.*
