March 17-18 and March 24-25, 2012

This is a 150 NCGA Player Points Tournament

Eligibility: This tournament is open to amateurs under the following conditions: Maximum 4.0 index using the March computation and must be verified by Association or Club Handicap. Handicap card or other verification must be presented prior to teeing off on the first day of the tournament.

Entry Fees: \$220 per team - Includes entry fee and **ALL** qualifying and match play green fees. Golf carts can be rented in the golf shop prior to play. No refunds after March 11, 2012. Field is limited to paid entries from the first 72 teams. Deadline for entry is 5:00 pm March 11, 2012. Returned checks will be assessed a \$20 fee.

Golf Ball: **The One Ball Rule Is NOT In Effect**

Format: **All play conducted under USGA rules. Play is at scratch.**

Four Ball stroke play qualifying round Saturday, March 17th- 8:00am

Playoffs: **In case of a playoff, All players must be present and ready to play**

1st Round matches 18 holes Sunday, March 18th-8:00am

2nd Round matches 18 holes Saturday, March 24th –7:30 morning tee times

3rd Round matches 18 holes Saturday, March 24th– 1:00 afternoon tee times

4th Round matches 18 holes Saturday, March 25th – 7:30 morning tee times

Championship match Sunday, March 25th – 1:00 pm afternoon tee times

Low 31 teams plus defending champions or low 32 teams will continue at 18 holes of Match Play (Defending Champions playing as a team shall receive automatic qualification into match play unless they elect to compete in the qualifying round). Ties will be broken by sudden death playoff from first hole.

Awards: This is a 150 NCGA Points event. Merchandise awards will be presented to all teams that qualify by winning two matches. The Champion's names will be inscribed on the perpetual trophy. Presentation of awards will take place immediately following the conclusion of each round. All winners are requested to be present to accept their awards.

Dress Code: Shirts with sleeves, no tank tops - shorts hemmed just above the knee or slacks - jeans are discouraged. Metal, penetrating golf shoe spikes are prohibited.

Registration: All rounds will start when scheduled. Contestants must check in on March 17th at least 20 minutes prior to their starting time. Starting times for all rounds will be posted at the Bing Maloney Golf Course.

Tee times for the qualifying round will be posted on the SGC website www.sacgolfcouncil.org one week before play. Player's scorecards, hole location and rules sheets will be handed out at registration for the qualifying round and on the 1st tee during match play. For those players coming from out of the Sacramento Area, Hotel suggestions are on the back of this application form.
