This is an NCGA Points Tournament:

200 level player point for seniors age 64 and under

50 level player point for super seniors age 65 and up

On-line Registration: sacgolfcouncil.org for online registration – please note \$15 administrative charge for any withdrawal for on-line registration.

- Eligibility:** Open to all male amateur golfers age 55 and older as of May 1 and are members of an organized golf club with an established USGA Index of 7.5 or less for championship flight and an Index of 19.8 or less for handicap flight.
- Entry Fees:** \$120 per player - Includes two (2) days green fees and awards—power cart not included. **Entry deadline is May 1 and no refunds after this date.** Entries received with a request for twosome pairings is acceptable. Request for a foursome is not allowed. There will be a \$25 service charge for returned checks.
- Format:** 36 holes of stroke play – 18 holes each day. Championship flight is played at scratch with an index of 7.5 or less. Ties for champion in this flight will be decided in a hole-by-hole playoff. Handicap flights play at full handicap of 19.8 or less. Ties in this flight are broken based on the USGA recommended method, Rule 33-6, Decision of Ties.
- Awards:** In the championship flight the individual with the lowest 36-hole gross score will be declared the 2010 **County Senior Men's Champion** and his name will be inscribed on the perpetual trophy. Ties in this flight are divided evenly by the sum of the combined places. Handicap flight awards are based on net scores.
- Rules:** Players will follow USGA Rules, except for local rules posted by the Tournament Committee prior to play. In the absence of a Rules Official, competitors shall use Rule 3-3 (Doubt as to Procedure, play a second ball) and refer any disputes to the Tournament Committee, whose decision shall be final. If any point in dispute is not covered by USGA or local rules, the decision shall be made in accordance with equity (Rule 1-4 - Points Not Covered by Rules.) The use of cellular phones/pagers is prohibited. GPS devices may be used for distance only.
- Times:** Players must check in at least 30 minutes prior to their scheduled starting time. It is the player's responsibility to be on the first tee at their assigned tee time (Rule 6.3). Late competitors must be ready to play within five minutes of their assigned tee time under a penalty of two (2) strokes. Penalty for failure to comply is disqualification. Starting times will be posted on the SGC website www.sacgolfcouncil.org one week prior to the event, or you may call the golf shop at (916) 482-3284, or Shirley Johnson, Tournament Director, at (916) 455-0590. To reserve power carts call the golf shop.
